Exodus 20 - Ten Commandments

- 1. You must not have any other god but me
- 2. You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind
- 3. You must not misuse the name of the Lord your God

Colossians 3:5 - So put to death the sinful, earthly things lurking within you. Have nothing to do with sexual immorality, impurity, lust, and evil desires. Don't be greedy, for a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world.

IDOL - anything that has been created that we exchange for the Creator

Romans 1:25 - They traded the truth about God for a lie. So they worshiped and served the things God created instead of the Creator himself, who is worthy of eternal praise!
