Acts 1:8 - "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you."

WE RECEIVE POWER

*Acts 1:6-11 - 6 So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, "Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?" 7 He replied, "The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know. 8 **But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you.**"*

POWER to overcome our SELFISHNESS

Romans 8:11-13 - 11 The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you. 12 Therefore, dear brothers and sisters, you have no obligation to do what your sinful nature urges you to do. 13 For if you live by its dictates, you will die. But if through the power of the Spirit you put to death the deeds of your sinful nature, you will live.

What selfishness do you need to surrender?

Acts 1:6-11 - 8 "And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

POWER to be more than a SPECTATOR

Are you settling for the sidelines?

Acts 1:6-11 - 9 After saying this, he was taken up into a cloud while they were watching, and they could no longer see him."10 As they strained to see him rising into heaven, two white-robed men suddenly stood among them. 11 "Men of Galilee," they said, "why are you standing here staring into heaven? Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday he will return from heaven in the same way you saw him go!"

POWER to live a life of SIGNIFICANCE

Matthew 6:10 - "May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven."
